
TOWN OF BEVENT RESIDENTS

WELCOME TO HARTERS FOX VALLEY DISPOSAL Weekly Trash and Recycling pickup on Wednesday.

Residents will be provided with (1) 95 gallon trash only cart. All residential trash must be bagged, tied, and fit in the cart provided. A separate (1) 95 gallon cart will be provided for recyclables (blue cart with green lid).

Garbage and Recycling needs to be curbside the night before scheduled pickup day to guarantee pickup.

- Please place trash cart as indicated in the picture, with the bar and lid opening street side. Recycling carts need to be placed NEXT to the trash cart on the same side of the driveway for collection. The collection system will require that the provided carts are mechanically picked up and then tipped into the truck. Residents are required to use provided carts for their household garbage and recyclables.
- Each household is allowed one cart of trash and one cart
 of recyclables per week. (Garbage must be bagged/tied
 and the cart cover must close). Do not put any garbage
 in the cart that is not bagged and tied. Use only clear or
 white trash bags. NO black or brown bags allowed.
 Recyclables do not need to be bagged.



- Place your cart(s) to maintain a (4) foot separation from obstructions, including other carts, mailboxes, parked cars, trees and snow banks
- Additional and Seasonal garbage carts are available for rent for a reduced fee per year.
- These carts are the property of Harter's, for cart repair or rental of additional carts; please call (715) 446-5400 or (888) 804-8556. In the event you move, these carts are to stay with the property.
- Holiday collection will be delayed one day, if the Holiday is on a weekday, for the following Holidays. Holidays are New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving and Christmas Day.
- Large household items will be collected on every other week at the expense of the resident. Pricing for these large household items are as follows: furniture (i.e. couch, table, dresser, bed frame, mattress, box spring, bike, push mower(no gas/oil), toilet, sink), electronics (i.e. stereo, printer, monitor, CPU tower) or Non-Freon appliances (i.e. stove, microwave, washer, dryer, compactor, dishwasher, humidifier, water heater, water conditioner) will be \$35.00 per item and Freon appliances (i.e. refrigerator, dehumidifier, freezer) and TV's will be \$60.00 per item.
- Residents are to call Harter's at (715) 446-5400 or (888) 804-8556 to schedule their large item pick-up, payment is required before pick-up. The cut off will be 2:00 p.m. the day prior to your pick-up day.

Yard waste, demo materials and waste oil cannot be accepted. For yard waste and demo material removal, call our office for pricing on a roll off dumpster

ACCEPTED RECYCLING The following items may be mixed together:

- <u>PLASTICS:</u> #1 thru #7 soft drink and water bottles, beer bottles, mouthwash, milk, water and juice containers, trash and retail bags, liquid detergent bottles, yogurt and margarine tubs, cereal box liners. All containers must be rinsed out and caps removed.
- **GLASS:** Check to make sure it's a glass bottle or jar, such as food jars, tea and soda bottles and beer and wine bottles. Do not include for recycling any non-container glass such as drinking glasses, ceramic coffee cups, Pyrex, mirrors, etc.
- **ALUMINUM CANS**: Do not crush cans. (cans only)
- **TIN/BI-METAL CANS**: Rinse out cans. (food cans only)
- CONTAINER FOR PAPER PRODUCTS/FIBERS
- <u>CORRUGATED CARDBOARD</u> Flatten boxes. Must be a maximum of 2ft x 3ft in size. They do not need to be tied. (All contaminated cardboard including pizza boxes should go in your regular trash.)
- OFFICE PAPER, NEWSPAPER
- MAGAZINES

Do Not Put into Recycling Bins:

- Plastic film or shrink wrap
- Any # plastic bag
- Plastic straws, plates, or silverware
- Drink pouches
- Foam or Polystyrene
- CD cases

- Aluminum baking pans or foil
- Liners (metal or plastic)
- Mirror or window glass
- Motor oil containers
- Light bulbs
- Ceramics or Clay pots
- Construction material (wood, drywall, windows, insulation, etc.)
- Soiled papers (tissues, towels, cardboard, etc.)
- Styrofoam (egg cartons, plates, hot beverage cups, formed packing pieces, or packing peanuts)
