Village of Rib Mountain Inquiring About Reserved Liquor License Availability. In 1997 a formula was contrived by the Wisconsin Towns Association pertaining to reserved liquor licenses in the municipality. The formula gave the town 1 reserved license and 3 available liquor licenses. This information was then relayed to the Department of Revenue. The Village of Rib Mountain was inquiring if the Town of Bevent had any reserved liquor licenses that the town would be willing to sell. The Village of Rib Mountain does not purchase the license. The business required to obtain the license would be purchasing the license from the town. The town must charge a minimum of \$10,000 for the license. **MOTION** by Cebula, 2nd by Wanta to hold the town's reserved liquor license for 2 years for a business in the Village of Rib Mountain.
