TOWN OF BEVENT, MARATHON COUNTY, WISCONSIN
ORDINANCE NUMBER ~~101~~ ENTITLED
"LOUD AND UNNECESSARY NOISE PROHIBITED"

The Town Board of the Town of Bevent, Marathon County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1: Ordinance Number 101 of the Town of Bevent entitled "LOUD AND UNNECESSARY NOISE PROHIBITED" is hereby created as follows:

ORDINANCE NUMBER 101

LOUD AND UNNECESSARY NOISE PROHIBITED

(1) PROHIBITED ACTS. No person, firm or corporation shall disturb the lawful quiet of any neighborhood or family or of any property, either public or private, within the Town of Bevent, by any act, conduct, vehicle, equipment or other device or means whatsoever, or shall cause to be made any loud, disturbing or unnecessary sounds or noises such as may tend to annoy or disturb another in or about any property either public or private. The operation of heavy machinery, including gravel crushers, in and around gravel pits between the hours of 9 p.m. and 6 a.m. is prohibited. Any such conduct herein prohibited is declared to be a public nuisance. Proof of such acts or disturbance having taken place on any premises, or in any building, shall be prima facie or presumptive evidence that the same occurred with the permission of the person exercising control over such building or premises.

(2) PENALTY.

(a) Any person, firm or corporation who violates any provision of this Ordinance shall upon conviction thereof be punished by a forfeiture of not less than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00), nor more than Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) together with costs of prosecution, and in default of the payment of such forfeiture and costs shall be committed to the County Jail for Marathon County, Wisconsin, for a period not exceeding thirty (30) days. In the interpretation of this Ordinance, each day during which any violation shall continue shall constitute a separate offense.

(b) In addition to the penalty hereinabove imposed for violation of this Ordinance, the cost of abating a public nuisance by the Town, including costs of any action brought by the Town to enjoin said

nuisance, shall be collected as a debt from the owner, occupant or person causing, permitting or maintaining the nuisance, and if notice to abate the nuisance has been given to the owner, such cost shall be assessed against the real estate as a special charge.

SECTION 2: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication.
